COLLEGE OF SOUTHERN IDAHO JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MARCH 18, 1968

CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the College of Southern Idaho Junior College District was called to order at 8:00 p.m. on Monday, March 18, 1968, by Acting Chairman, John Coleman, in the Executive Office of the College.

Present were: Trustees John R. Coleman, James Shields, and Robert Blastock, Jr.; President James L. Taylor, Attorney Robert Alexander, and Secretary-Treasurer Herb Van Slyke. Absent because of illness: Trustees Eldon V. Evans and John R. Garrabrandt.

MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees on February 19, 1968 were reviewed and, upon MOTION by Mr. Blastock, seconded by Mr. Shields, approved as written.

TREASURER'S REPORT

The February Report of the District's Treasurer, having been mailed previous to the meeting, was subjected to discussion. Upon MOTION by Mr. Blastock, seconded by Mr. Shields, the February 1968 report of the District's Treasurer was approved and accepted as submitted.

PAYMENT OF BILLS, APPROVAL OF PAYROLL

Referred to the Board for consideration and approval for payment were:

- 1. Regular bills and expense items for the month of February, 1968, in the aggregate amount of \$42,946.66.
- 2. Payrolls for the month of March, including Work-Study (gross) \$44,484.24.

An abstract of the foregoing bills and expenses and a recap of the payrolls were mailed to each trustee prior to this meeting.

Upon MOTION by Mr. Shields, seconded by Mr. Blastock, the Board of Trustees approved for payment the bills and payroll hereinabove stated.

EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONNEL

Dr. Taylor recommended the employment of Larry Garrett as a Vocational Farm Technician Program Instructor at \$5.00 per hour for this program.

Upon MOTION by Mr. Shields, seconded by Mr. Blastock, the Board of Trustees approved the employment of Larry Garrett as recommended by Dr. Taylor.

RESIGNATION OF DR. DON L. KEITH

The Board of Trustees was advised officially that Dr. Don L. Keith had tendered his resignation from the staff of the College of Southern Idaho effective about April 15, 1968, to accept a position as Executive Director for the Board of Higher Education, State of Idaho.

A MOTION was made by Mr. Blastock, seconded by Mr. Shields, that the Board accept, with regret, the resignation of Dr. Don L. Keith. Upon being put to a vote, the motion carried unanimously.

REEMPLOYMENT OF FACULTY AND STAFF, SALARY ADJUSTMENTS

Dr. Taylor submitted to the Board of Trustees a list of the names of all faculty and staff personnel with salary schedules, existing and proposed, for each employee. He also apprised the Board of the additional faculty and staff (possibly fourteen more) who will undoubtedly be needed this fall. He recommended the reemployment of those listed at the increased salaries proposed.

After due consideration, a MOTION was made by Mr. Shields, seconded by Mr. Blastock, that the Board of Trustees approve the reemployment of the instructional and non-instructional personnel, at the proposed increased salary schedules to become effective June 1, 1968 for those employed on the calendar year, and on September 1, 1968 for those on the academic year, as listed and recommended by Dr. Taylor. Being put to a vote, the motion carried unanimously. (Copy of list and salary schedule attached hereto.)

DORMITORY-STUDENT UNION

It was reported that the prospects are currently not too bright for funding the construction of this proposed facility. Interest is too high on private capital, the bond market is difficult, and federal money may be hard to come by. Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees Monday, March 18, 1968

LYONS PROPERTY

After a brief discussion of the advisability of early acquisition of the small tract of land owned by Mr. Lyons and lying within the campus perimeter, the members of the Board agreed unanimously to authorize Dr. Taylor to purchase said tract providing it can be done within the \$10,000 to \$15,000 price range.

FINE ARTS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Dr. Taylor reviewed in detail the initial meeting of the Fine Arts Advisory Committee which met in full committee on Friday, March 15th.

SPACE NEEDS FOR VOCATIONAL SCHOOL

The unfilled need for space for program expansion of the vocational school was again drawn to attention; Wanzanreid may reconsider, although, the cost of remodeling is a problem; the former Bestway Builders property appears to have possibilities, including substantial parking area and will be further investigated.

TREES IN CAMPUS AREA

Mr. Blastock told the Board that he had been approached regarding the purchase of trees in the campus area which will apparently have to be removed. The architect is now checking to determine how many of them can be used on the campus.

ADJOURNMENT

No further business appearing, a MOTION was made by Mr. Shields, seconded by Mr. Blastock, that the meeting be adjourned. So order and done.
