COLLEGE OF SOUTHERN IDAHO JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING August 19, 1974

CALL TO ORDER: 8:00 p.m. PRESIDING: John Hepworth

ATTENDING: Trustees: John Hepworth, Robert Blastock and Eldon Evans.

John Coleman was absent.

College Administration: Dr. James L. Taylor, President, Karl L. Black, Secretary-Treasurer, Jerry Meyerhoeffer, Assistant to the President and Bob Alexander, attorney.

<u>Visitors</u>: Annette Jenkins, Statesman; Bill Lazarus, TimeseNews; and Eugene Stacey.

MINUTES OF JULY 15 were approved as written upon MOTION by Mr. Blastock, seconded by Mr. Evans. Affirmative vote unanimous.

TREASURER'S REPORT FOR JULY, 1974, was approved upon MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

BILLS PAYABLE included vouchers #1 through #245 totaling \$97,251.16; fund transfers covered by vouchers #246 through #252 amounted to \$75,993.65.

July payrolls were: Regular \$217, 365.78; Work Study \$20, 426.20.

A MOTION by Mr. Blastock, seconded by Mr. Evans approved payment of the bills, and the transfer of funds and acknowledged the July payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PERSONNEL: The Board accepted the resignation and employed the personnel indicated on the attached sheet on MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

TRANSFER: Pamela L. Gillen of Gooding County requested a transfer to North Idaho College as the nursing program at the College of Southern Idaho was filled. Transfer was approved on MOTION by Mr. Evans seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

SCHOLARSHIPS & LOANS: According to the attached schedules, scholarships and loans were approved on MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

ATTORNEY'S REPORT: Another claim as a result of the Frontier Field fire has been filed against the College for \$25,000 by Bill Schulz. The claim was formally rejected as well as all future claims that may be incurred as a result of the fire on MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

NEW BOARD MEMBER: Mr. LeRoy Craig of Jerome was appointed to fill the unexpired term of Reverand John Garrabrandt who resigned, on June 25, 1974. Mr. Craig's term will expire in December 1974.

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CERTIFICATION OF TAX LEVY: Pursuant to Idaho Code, the Board of Trustees approved the tax levy for 1975 on MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: This week the College is conducting faculty workshops and registration for the fall term. According to Mr. Meyerhoeffer, most vocational programs are filled. Vocational numbers are ahead of last year. Academic numbers are about the same as last year.

Core samples have been taken on the new parking lot for testing of compaction and gravel base. The parking lot should be completed soon.

There will be a meeting at 9:00 a.m. Tuesday, August 20 with the architect concerning the proposed building at Frontier Field.

The State Board of Education has asked for a five year projection on building requests. The Board reaffirmed that vocational needs held priority.

On the budget request for fiscal year 1976, the College has followed the guidelines of the State Board of Education.

In conversation with the Regional Officer on Federal Building, there has been some indication that the guidelines for applying for federal assistance may change. Should this happen, it may be advisable to go ahead with the application for a \$50,000 grant to help build a lecture hall museum facility
