COLLEGE OF SOUTHERN IDAHO JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING March 17, 1975

CALL TO ORDER: 8:00 p.m. PRESIDING: LeRoy Craig

MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 17, 1975, were approved as written upon MOTION by Mr. Coleman, seconded by Mr. Evans. Affirmative vote unanimous.

TREASURER'S REPORT for FEBRUARY 1975, was approved upon MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Mr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #239 totaling \$1,060,785.25; fund transfers covered by vouchers #240 through #248 amounted to \$139,848.69.

February payrolls were: Regular \$182,728.79 Work Study \$12,554.19

A MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Mr. Coleman approved the disbursements, and the transfer of funds and acknowledged the February payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PERSONNEL: Granting of new contracts at an average pay increase of 9.7% per the attached schedule was approved on MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Mr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

AUDIT: The audit report for the 1973-74 fiscal year was accepted on MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Mr. Coleman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

CATALOG: A bid to print 8,000 copies of the 1975-76 school catalog was let to the low bidder. Taylor Publishing Company, Covina, California. The bid price was \$5,518. The MOTION was by Mr. Coleman, seconded by Mr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

LOANS: Educational Trust Loans of \$250 and a Blaine Curtis Trust Loan of \$150 were approved on MOTION by Mr. Lehrman, seconded by Mr. Coleman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

FEES: Fees were increased \$2.00 per student per semester. The fees to be identified as \$1.00 per student for male athletics and \$1.00 per student for female athletics. The MOTION was made by Mr. Evans, seconded by Mr. Coleman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: There are three items of legislative concern that have required a great amount of time.

- 1. Word was received orally that the additional \$400,000 on the vocational technical building has been approved. The Director of Public Works will probably call for bids, and it should provide an additional 8 to 10,000 square feet on the new vocational technical building now under construction.
- 2. Legislation is being considered to follow the State Board of Education recommendation in lump sum appropriations for each of the junior colleges to replace the current distribution on the basis of FTE students.
- 3. It is doubtful if legislation will pass which would have distributed 50% of liquor fund monies in a junior college area directly to the College. This would have enabled the students coming from those counties to pay the same tuition as indistrict students.

Dr. Taylor was chairman of a meeting of the Northwest and Western Regional Accrediting Associations. The two associations are considering a merger to strengthen the association and oppose accreditation by the federal government.

As indicated in the last meeting, the College of Southern Idaho will host the Higher Commission of the Northwest Accrediting Association on June 17, 18, and 19. This will be their first meeting outside of Oregon or Washington.

DR. TAYLOR was recognized for the 10th anniversary of his employment and and the beginning of the College of Southern Idaho.
