CALL TO ORDER: 8:05 p.m. PRESIDING: LeRoy Craig

MINUTES OF MAY 19, 1975, were approved as written upon MOTION by Mr. Coleman, seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

TREASURER'S REPORT for MAY 1975, was approved upon MOTION by Mr. Coleman, seconded by Dr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #262 totaling \$271,826.11; fund transfers covered by vouchers #263 through #272 amounted to \$60,292.25.

May payrolls were: Regular \$183,682.31 Work Study \$13,719.25

A MOTION by Mr. Blastock seconded by Mr. Coleman approved the disbursements, and the transfer of funds and acknowledged the May payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PERSONNEL: Hiring of four employees on the attached schedule was approved on Motion by Mr. Coleman, seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

BUDGET: The budget of \$3,599,211 for Fiscal Year 1976 was approved on MOTION by Mr. Blastock, seconded by Mr. Coleman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

EXPOSITION CENTER: Mr. Alexander, College Attorney, presented the signed contract for the new exposition center.

JUNE 16, 1975, CSI Trustee Meeting

LOANS:

Three educational trust loans for \$100 each were approved on MOTION by Mr. Coleman, seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

LITIGATION: Dr. Taylor reported that he had completed an interrogatory on the Frontier Field Fire for the insurance company's attorney's.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

The architect has been directed to put in an alternate bid for curb and gutter work along with the bid for the additional construction on the new vo-tech building.

Dr. Taylor reported meeting with the contractor and the architect concerning the faulty roofs on the Fine Arts and Academic buildings. The following steps are being taken.

- The architect has submitted the names of three 1. experts to contact for recommendations on a solution to the problem.
- The architect agreed to contact the vendor of the roof materials to request that he provide new materials for the roofs.
- 3. The architect agreed to determine if design problems could be the cause of the buckling.

The Higher Commission of the Northwest Accrediting Association will hold its semi-annual meeting in Twin Falls during the next three days. They will be reviewing fourteen schools for accreditation. They plan to tour the campus facilities while in Twin Falls.

Summer school is currently underway with special camps for boys basketball; girls basketball and gymnastics; there will also be a three day fire school for Idaho firemen. The Jobies will meet on campus June 26, 27 and 28. 600 to 1000 young ladies are expected to attend.

We are currently preparing narrative guidelines on the STATE BUDGET: FY 77 budget for the State Board of Education to consider in their July meeting.

CHAIRMAN CRAIG indicated that as a result of the Board's tour of the College facilities, he was very impressed with the condition and cleanliness of the buildings and grounds. He complimented Mr. McManaman, Physical Plant Director.

PRESIDENT TAYLOR: suggested that the Board might want to "come to grips" very soon with the question of tuition and fees waiver for faculty and staff.
