MINUTES OF JUNE 23, 1975, were approved as written upon MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Dr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

TREASURER'S REPORT for June, was approved upon MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Dr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #289 including 61-A, 119-A 150-A, and 251-A totaling \$158,154.08; fund transfers covered by vouchers #290 through #297 amounted to \$8,868.53. Vouchers #1 through #34 totaling \$31,073.47 were approved to be charged to Fiscal Year 1976 Budget.

A MOTION by Dr. Lehrman seconded by Mr. Evans approved the disbursements, and the transfer of funds and acknowledged the June payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

A MOTION was made to approve a bill submitted by the architect on the exposition center; payment subject to Dr. Taylor's discretion was made by Dr. Lehrman, seconded by Mr. Evans. In the same MOTION the business manager was authorized to write checks for reimbursement for expenses of E.P.D.A. workshop participants. The exact amount is unknown at this time, but will be fully reimbursed by state vo-ed. Affirmative vote unanimous.

Chairman Craig, on behalf of the board and administration COMMENDATIONS: presented plaques and expressed gratitude for services to the College of Mr. Jim Kinney, Twin Falls, who served as chairman of the Fine Arts Lyceum Committee from 1968 through 1974 and Mr. John Hepworth, Buhl, who served as chairman of the Board of Trustees from 1971 through 1974. <u>PERSONNEL</u>: Employment of James Woods, Leta Obray, Emalee G. Klimes, and Shirley Cole was approved on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman, seconded by Mr. Evans. Affirmative vote unanimous.

NORTH IDAHO COLLEGE: Approval of Richard Hitt from Cassia County to attend North Idaho College was approved on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman, seconded by Mr. Coleman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

BIDS:

All bids on a lift truck for the vocational school were rejected on MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Mr. Coleman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

LEASE: of the Sinclair Service Station Building on the corner of 9th and Shoshone was approved at \$350.00 per month on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman, seconded by Mr. Coleman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

SCHOLARSHIP AND LOANS: four Cenex Scholarships, 24 Educational Trust
Scholarships, and three loans were approved on MOTION by
Mr. Evans, seconded by Dr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

Note: Mr. Blastock came into the meeting.

#### PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

Dr. Taylor appeared at the State Board of Education Budget Hearing last week. The State Board approved budget requests for roof repair, Office on Aging program, womens athletics, and public service. The request for sabbatical leave was approved at a reduced figure of \$15,000.00.

The President of the State Board, Mrs. Janet Hay, requested that the local board reconsider the use of NCHEMS. After considerable discussion MOTION was made by Mr. Blastock that due to the additional cost and time involved and the fact that our computer would not handle the NCHEMS program that we respectfully decline the implementation of NCHEMS at this time. The MOTION was seconded by Mr. Evans. Affirmative vote unanimous.

Due to problems with drainage water at the site of the exposition center the attached change order was approved on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman, seconded by Mr. Evans. Affirmative vote unanimous.
