MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 15, 1975, were approved as written upon MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

TREASURER'S REPORT FOR SEPTEMBER, 1975, was approved upon MOTION by Mr. Blastock, seconded by Mr. Evans. Affirmative vote unanimous.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #341 totaling \$1,148,442.17;
fund transfers covered by vouchers #342 through #347 amounted to \$11,098.14. Checks #23 and #24 totaling \$455,176.85 on the Plant Facilities Fund were also approved.

September payrolls were: Regular \$193,630.70 Work Study \$11,171.48

A MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Mr. Blastock approved the disbursements, and the transfer of funds and acknowledged the September payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

LOANS:

A \$200 grain growers loan to Dale Thomas was approved on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman, seconded by Mr. Coleman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

ATTORNEY'S REPORT: Campus Security has come to Mr. Alexander with a problem concerning enforcement of traffic regulations. He has drafted regulations to present to the City Council for approval. If approved, these regulations would be enforceable through the City Court.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Dr. Taylor reported that the by-laws for the Historical Arts, Inc. had been changed to provide tax exempt status for the organization.

Construction on Exposition Center and new Vo Tech Building is moving along well.

Enrollment is up about 6.4%.

MR. EVANS REPORTED that the remaining funds of the Civic Auditorium

Association should be available soon for use in the Herrett's

Museum.
