REORGANIZATION: Pursuant to Idaho Code, the Board of Trustees was reorganized as follows: Chairman, LeRoy Craig; Vice Chairman, Dr. Charles Lehrman; Clerk, William Babcock.

SCHOLARSHIPS: for Steve Beer, \$150.00 and David Olivas, \$125.00 were approved on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman, seconded by Mr. Babcock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: The group that asked for special zoning for a handball and racquetball building south of campus were turned down by the zoning committee.

Dr. Taylor was in Boise last week meeting with legislators. The Governor's budget recommendation included a \$156,200.00 increase for the two junior colleges on the basis of last year's enrollment. CSI would receive about fifty-two percent of the increase with the present distribution formula.

As of this morning about 1,400 students have enrolled for spring semester. This would probably increase our percentage of the budget distribution since it is based on full-time equivalency.

The Governor's budget included liquor funds as part of the state revenue. I disagree with this since the money accrues to the county and any money we receive has to be replaced by the county.

We proposed three new items of legislation.

- 1. A bill to increase the gymnasium and grounds levy from $\frac{1}{2}$ to $2\frac{1}{2}$ mills and change the restriction to buildings and grounds. We could not find a sponsor for this bill.
- 2. A bill to increase tuition paid by the student to \$100.00 and make it apply to in-district and out-of-district students with the counties paying an additional amount for out-of-district. This bill will be introduced.
- 3. A bill to change junior college distribution from the full-time equivalency formula to a program budget. This bill will be introduced.

It was recommended by a legislator that the two junior colleges propose a recodification next year with the approval of the State Board.
