MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 21, 1977, were approved as written upon MOTION by Mr. Coleman, seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

TREASURER'S REPORT for November 1977, was accepted upon MOTION by

Mr. Blastock, seconded by Mr. Babcock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #287 totaling \$350,132.13; including 71A, 214A fund transfers covered by vouchers #288 through #296 amounted to \$6,332.56.

November payrolls were: Regular \$259,360.10

Work/Study \$ 13,356.89

A MOTION by Mr. Coleman seconded by Mr. Blastock approved the disbursements, and the transfer of funds and acknowledged the November payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

SCHOLARSHIPS: Five scholarships totaling \$1,000 were approved and one scholarship for \$100 was canceled, on MOTION by Mr. Coleman, seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PERSONNEL: The resignation of Lester Sherrill as Consumer Electronics Instructor, and Ray Sabala as Welding Instructor, was accepted by the Board. The employment of Ed Prescott and Gib Anderson was approved on MOTION by Mr. Babcock, seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: The facilities at the College will be closed for the week between Christmas and New Year's. This should result in an energy savings and also allow the staff to have the week off.

Dr. Taylor reported on construction: The Art Cottage is almost completed. We are working on building dividers in the Study Skills Center, some outside restrooms by the bleachers at Frontier Field, also an outside arena area next to the Expo Center.

We are not in a very good position for state funding this year. The Governor's budget provided very little for junior colleges. It will probably take a great deal of my time in Boise during the legislativie session to try to get additional funds.

The pre-enrollment at this time is ahead of the same time last year. The Fall term enrollment showed an increase in about 11 percent over last year.

Last year we advertised a 1924 Model-T Show Car for sale on closed bid. We also called for and received appraisals from four disinterested parties. The appraisals were \$3000, \$2900, \$1950 and \$1250. The average of the appraisals would be \$2275. At that time we received one sealed bid for \$500 which was rejected by the Board. At that time we met all requirements of the state law for disposal of college equipment.

On December 8 we received an offer from a Don Williams of \$2000 cash and a two-wheeled, electric brake, four place, flatbed snowmobile trailer. The trailer is manufactured by Earl's Trailer Manufacturing in Twin Falls and retails for \$1495 new. It is about one year old and has had very little use. It could be of value to us in our recreational vehicle program. It is my recommendation that the Board of Trustees accept this offer.
