DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #250 totaling \$174,584.34; including addendum of \$22,021.40 fund transfers covered by vouchers #251 through #257 amounted to \$40,811.28.

Work/Study \$ 8,334.62

A MOTION by Mr. Blastock seconded by Mr. Babcock approved the disbursements, and the transfer of funds and acknowledged the June payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

- SCHOLARSHIPS AND LOANS: Thirty-nine scholarships for the fall semester and one loan previously advanced, were approved on MOTION by Mr. Babcock, seconded by Mr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.
- PRESIDENT'S REPORT: We have been asked to file a contingency budget,
  based on a 30% reduction, we have also been asked to identify
  additional possible areas of revenue. One of the few possibilities would be -- increase in tuition and fees.

Permanent Building Fund, as indicated by several legislators, would be the first project to be eliminated if the 1% Inititive should pass.

The prospect for the federal funding on the new vocational building looks very favorable.

Dr. Taylor will be meeting with representatives of Trus-Joist Corporation to solicit either materials or contributions for building of the museum.

The week of July 24, Dr. Taylor will be meeting with the AACJC Board in Washington, D. C.

Funding for the museum is progressing satisfactorily.
