DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #323 totaling \$188,433.27; fund transfers covered by vouchers #324 through #330 amounted to \$13,471.19.

EMPLOYMENT: Mr. Phil Sampson was employed as Area Planner for the Area IV IOOA program, on MOTION by Mr. Blastock, seconded by Mr. Coleman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND LOANS: Four scholarships totaling \$575 per semester and five loans totaling \$430 were approved on MOTION by Mr. Coleman seconded by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Dr. Taylor has contacted the engineering firms of CH2M Hill and CTA to engineer the hot water resource to be

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: used on campus for energy purposes. The plan will (Cont'd) be used on application for federal funds with the Department of Energy and the Regional Office in Seattle for HEW. The agreement is that the cost of the plans shall not exceed \$10,000. A MOTION to approve this action was made by Mr. Blastock, seconded by Dr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

Secretary-Treasurer

Dr. Taylor reported to the Board that the new vo-tech building is number two on the Permanent Building Fund priority list. This would provide \$800,000 of state funds for use in construction of the vo-tech building and would be used as match for \$1,200,000 in federal funds. This would allow our Recreational Vehicles our Farm Mechanics programs and some of our vocational classes that are now being held in the academic building to be moved to the new location. This would free up some much needed space in the Shields Academic building.
