MINUTES OF: June 18, 1979, were approved as written upon MOTION by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

TREASURER'S REPORT for June, was accepted upon MOTION by Mr. Babcock.

Affirmative vote unanimous.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #306 totaling \$239,534.47; including 101A, 146A fund transfers covered by vouchers #307 through #312 amounted to \$8,019.12.

June payrolls were: Regular \$341,184.61 Work/Study 8,814.80

A MOTION by Mr. Hamilton approved the disbursements and the transfer of funds and acknowledged the June payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

- SCHOLARSHIPS AND LOANS: A loan of \$100, scholarships for the Fall semester of \$5,125 and for the Spring semester of \$4,850 were all approved on MOTION my Mr. Blastock.
- TRUSTEES' ANNUAL MEETING: Dr. Taylor reported that the annual meeting of the Association of Community College Trustees would be held in Detroit October 3-6. Mr.Blastock moved that anyone on the Board of Trustees desiring to attend this convention be approved by the Board at this time. Affirmative vote unanimous.
- PRESIDENT'S REPORT: The geothermal well is 1,840 feet deep. We will hold a meeting of the committee next week to analyze the well and make a recommendation as to what should be done at this time. We have reduced the size of the hole to 8 inches, are still in red rhyolite and have been for about 600 feet. Tomorrow we will run a log on the well and take temperature tests with a little more sophisticated equipment.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: In late August we intend to hold a workshop on geothermal energy for public school superintendents and legislators.

The museum is about 47% complete.

Pre-enrollment for the Fall term looks good. The dormitories have been filled for some time.

Doug Moore, Manager of KMVT requested that the Board give their sanction to a rezoning change to an R4 zone to allow KMVT to build a new studio adjacent to college property. The Board agreed to examine the property later this week and respond to Mr. Moore's request.
