MINUTES OF: August 20, 1979, were approved as written upon MOTION by Mr. Hamilton. Affirmative vote unanimous.

TREASURER'S REPORT for August, was accepted upon MOTION by Mr. Babcock.

Affirmative vote unanimous.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #326 totaling \$238,101.09; fund transfers covered by vouchers #327 through #334 amounted to \$66,099.19.

August payrolls were: Regular \$332,098.68 Work/Study 8,158.44

A MOTION by Mr. Lehrman approved the disbursements and the transfer of funds and acknowledged the August payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

- LOANS AND SCHOLARSHIPS: Five loans totaling \$150 and one scholarship for \$125 were approved on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.
- EDUCATIONAL TRUST FUND: Dr. Taylor reported that it is his intention to transfer the responsibility of trustee for the Educational Trust Fund from Twin Falls Bank & Trust to the College. A resolution to create a bank account for this purpose and also for the Endowment Trust Fund was approved on MOTION by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.
- PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Dr. Taylor reported that we have been renting an Outreach building in Burley for some time but would like to secure a more suitable building.

We are having a parking space problem at Kimberly Road. I have therefore asked for an appraisal on the Brennan Building. To meet Idaho Code we must have three appraisals. After receiving

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: the appraisals, we can then determine if the building should be sold and the programs relocated on campus.

Dr. Taylor reported that there had been an Energy Conference held last Thursday and Friday with representative's from five states. They are writing a proposal to secure federal dollars for energy research. In conjunction with some of the energy projects going on on campus, Dr. Taylor reported that it has been the policy of the College for some time that something produced at the College belongs to the College. Dr. Taylor also showed the Board a model of a non-directional windmill that is being experimented with.
