MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 17, 1980, were approved as written upon MOTION by Dr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

TREASURER'S REPORT for November, was accepted upon MOTION by Mr. Blastock.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #400 and #500 through #597 totaling \$224,622.34; including 309A fund transfers covered by vouchers #401 through #406 amounted to \$15,766.47.

November payrolls were: Regular \$390,679.36

Work/Study \$ 15,022.67

A MOTION by Mr. Hamilton approved the disbursements and the transfer of funds and acknowledged the November payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous. Mr. Blastock moved that Dr. Taylor's travel vouchers be approved. Affirmative vote unanimous.

SCHOLARSHIPS: Six scholarships totaling \$1,425 were approved on MOTION by Mr. Blastock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

BONDURANT'S: Mr. Bondurant asked about Dr. Taylor's contract and Mrs.

Bondurant wanted to know when the election results would be in and when the votes would be canvassed.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: There were two meetings on campus today, one to finalize the agreement to hold the State Fire Academy at C.S.I. This would include the entire State of Idaho. We anticipate training in excess of 2,000 people a year. The second meeting was to finalize a program for training of Soil Conservationist's in fish technology. The program would last about two weeks in June and costs would be defrayed by charging a seminar fee.
