TREASURER'S REPORT for APRIL was accepted upon MOTION by Mr. Blastock MOTION carried.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #271 and #501 through #597 totaling \$173,044.50; including 112A fund transfers covered by vouchers #272 through #277 amounted to \$19,034.49.

FOOD SERVICE EQUIPMENT: The 1980-81 budget was amended to accept bids for #124,201.85 worth of Food Service Training Program Equipment on MOTION by Mr. Hamilton. MOTION carried.

SCHOLARSHIPS: Three scholarships from the King Broadcasting Company account in the scholarship fund were approved on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman. MOTION carried.

BUDGET:

Mr. Craig announced that the budget would be approved at the June 15 meeting, and a copy would be available in the CSI Board Room from Thursday, June 11 through the June 15 Board Meeting.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Dr. Taylor indicated that he was very pleased with the graduation exercise.

The College is currently drawing up a contract for a 15 year lease on the new property and spring to be used for propagation of trout. The College will have to prepare the area, but the lease does not cost anything.

We have had unusual wind damage to some of the campus trees and shrubs, which are being replaced.

We are working with the City on the Frontier Field baseball area to maintain it and secure funds for some blacktopping.

It is hopeful that the summer school enrollment will be good. There was some question about holding summer school, but we plan to go ahead.

The Geothermal Well #2 is producing 1200 plus gallons per minute. The system for use of the water is installed in our new building, and we plan to extend it to the Vo Tech Center and possibly the Physical Education Building.

The total bid specifications called for some equipment for remote communications off-campus.

Bids for the total package were:

Since the need for off-campus communication is indefinite at this time, we have reduced the bid for this portion of the equipment to the following:

Hewlett Packard 210,978.12

National Cash Register 257,495.00

It is recommended to the Board that we accept the low bid of Hewlett Packard as follows:

System Hardware \$210,978.12

System Software 8,705.05

Application Software (vendor to be determined) 30,000.00

It is further recommended that the expenditure be taken from the funded reserve and accumulated interest that was established 2 years ago with the original bid.
