MINUTES OF AUGUST 17, 1981, were approved as written upon MOTION by Dr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

TREASURER'S REPORT for AUGUST, was accepted upon MOTION by Mr. Babcock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #317 and #501 through #615 totaling \$2,244,711.41; including 57A, 221A, 510A, 609A, 610A; fund transfers covered by vouchers #318 through #325 amounted to \$96,843.01.

August payrolls were: Regular \$425,331.70 Work Study \$ 8,848.35

A MOTION by Dr. Lehrman approved the disbursements and the transfer of funds and acknowledged the August payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

BIDS:

Bids for the proposed College Energy Management and Control System were considered. The Board awarded the bid to Western Energy Controls of Orem, Utah, with a total bid price of \$335,580 to be paid from the Plant Facilities Reserve Fund on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

SCHOLARSHIP: A scholarship from the Robert Eugene McGuire Scholarship Memorial was awarded to Natalie J. Vallejo on MOTION by Mr. Babcock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

RESIGNATION: Chairman Craig read a letter from Lloyd Hamilton resigning from the Board of Trustees effective September 21, 1981. The reason given for his resignation was an LDS mission call that would take him out of Twin Falls until the summer of 1983. The resignation was accepted on MOTION by Mr. Babcock.
