PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Jerry Meyerhoeffer reported that the House of Representatives has held up the tuition bill for junior colleges on a MOTION by Representative Boyd. He has contacted Representative Boyd and is assured of his support when the bill comes up for third reading tomorrow. It appears that an omnibus revenue bill to increase state revenue will be considered prior to action by the Joint Finance Appropriations Committee.
