PRESIDENT'S REPORT: President Meyerhoeffer reported that he had spent most of last week in Boise. He met with the Governor concerning the Governor's recommendation on junior college funding for this year. The Governor was very receptive to the ideas put forth and requested that his financial analyst seek additional information on the community colleges. The information has been put together and sent to the Governor's budget office.

President Meyerhoeffer further reported that much of this week will be spent in Boise. His presentation to the Joint Appropriation Committee will be on Thursday morning and he will request that we be treated equitably with other facets of education. The last five years have seen a disproportionate amount of the funding come from local effort.

Registration for the spring semester looks good. However, we do not have the final count at this time.

The student government has been invited to have dinner with us this evening.

President Meyerhoeffer also expressed his pleasure and enjoyment in seeing many members of the student body, faculty, and staff participate in the production of Fiddler on the Roof.
