PRESIDENT'S REPORT: The committee working on new stalls for the Expo Building has been meeting and investigating systems available and their cost. Their next meeting is scheduled for March 18, 1984.

The accreditation team will be on campus March 26 through 29 for their review. President Meyerhoeffer commended Dr. Strawser and the entire staff for the job done on the self-study.

The College of Southern Idaho Foundation, Inc., board has met and is now active. The members are very enthusiastic, and it appears that they plan some very positive action.

President Meyerhoeffer also reported that Marvin Glasscock is in St. Luke's hospital in Boise undergoing some tests and treatment for a heart condition. Mail can be sent to him in care of the hospital.
