MINUTES OF JUNE 14, 1985, were approved as written on MOTION by Mr. Babcock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

TREASURER'S REPORT FOR JUNE 1985 was accepted upon MOTION by Dr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #196 and #501 through #593 and #701 through #708 and #801 through #830 totaling \$423,387.83

A MOTION by Scholes approved the disbursements and transfer of funds and acknowledged the June payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: President Meyerhoeffer reported the following:

- 1. We received information from the state several weeks ago indicating that there would probably be a 3 percent holdback. The governor's office has now made a new projection and anticipates that, if there is a holdback, it will be less than half the amount originally expected.
- 2. We have accepted the resignation of Jim Bob Taylor. He resigned to go into private business. We will probably not replace that position for one year, which would help, if there is a holdback. As a result of that opening, we will probably combine the two cafeterias in the vocational area. We have been considering doing this for some time. We have also been contacted by SAGA Foods, and they are planning to make a proposal to us on contracting for our food service.
- 3. Bob McManaman has indicated that the Taylor Building addition is about two weeks behind on construction. Part of the reason is that we have rejected the brick three times, either because of the quality or the color. There is also some delay in other materials.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT CONTINUED:

- 4. The July 4 celebration at CSI was very successful. There were many people here and very little problem with cleanup the following day. Idaho Frozen Foods is to be commended for the fireworks display they put on.
- 5. President Meyerhoeffer reported that he had been away to school for about three weeks. One of his professors was Dr. Raymond Young. Dr. Young had been Dr. Taylor's major professor at college and and also been chairman of the selection committee for the CSI site. Plans are to invite Dr. Young to the CSI campus at a later date to meet with the board and assess some of the things we are doing.
- 6. Terry Uhlig will be presenting a brief to Judge Hurlbut within the next few days concerning hot water use for irrigation. It is expected that the Judge will give some ruling on the irrigation question within a month.
