MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 16, 1985 were approved as written on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

TREASURER'S REPORT FOR SEPTEMBER was accepted upon MOTION by Mr. Babcock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #372 and #501 through #613 and $\overline{#}701$ through #707 totaling \$359,566.97.

A MOTION by Dr. Scholes approved the disbursements and transfer of funds and acknowledged the September payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

BANK ACCOUNT: A resolution to open a bank account with First Security Bank with the purpose of depositing continuing education funds in Hailey was approved on MOTION by Mr. Babcock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: President Meyerhoeffer reported the following:

- 1. An agreement with Blaine County Community Education has been entered into by the College of Southern Idaho. A copy of the agreement and enrollment report was passed out to the board. The college had planned to start the programs in January. Blaine County Community Ed had encouraged them to start early. Classes have already begun.
- 2. If the weather holds, we will be doing some work on college streets. Brian Chase, with the State Division of Public Works, has approved about \$70,000 in street repairs. Last years was the first time community colleges were allowed to participate in this type of maintenance funds.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT CONTINUED:

- 3. The 20th anniversary celebration was a very positive experience. Thanks were extended especially to Dr. Joan Edwards and Annette Jenkins for their work in planning and organizing.
- 4. We are in the process of remodeling the house near the Expo Center for a child care facility. Bob McManaman has been asked to look at the facility with the idea of expansion for next year.
- 5. We have been asked to respond to a possible holdback on the basis of 2.5 percent and 5 percent. If we have to go to the 5 percent, it will have a serious impact on the college. It would mean the possibility of discontinuing summer school or a change in salary level.
- 6. Construction on the Taylor Administration Building addition is about $2\frac{1}{2}$ months behind. We are look at some time in March now as a possible date to utilize the facility. The electrical bid is to be opened on October 30.
- 7. A national accreditation team will be visiting the Herrett Museum. If accreditation is given, it would be the only museum to receive national accreditation in the state of Idaho.
- 8. We have been in contact with the city on extension of the North Campus road to Blue Lakes Boulevard. The possibility of extending the road looks fairly positive at this time.
- 9. We received a report from Terry Uhling on the progress of the litigation of the geothermal water resource. The written report was passed out to the board.

RESOLUTION TO OPEN NEW BANK ACCOUNT

- WHEREAS, tuition and fees will be collected on said educational offering, and
- WHEREAS, the Bank handling the College of Southern Idaho General Fund does not have a branch Bank in Hailey.
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the College of Southern Idaho open an account with First Security Bank of Idaho to be used as a depository and a clearing account for tuition and fees collected in the Hailey area, and

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said account shall bear the signatures of Karl L. Black, Business Manager, and R. H. Sterling, Assistant Business Manager, only one signature required.
