CERTIFICATION OF PROPERTY TAX LEVY: The certification of a levy of \$2,490,000 to Jerome and Twin Falls Counties was approved on MOTION by Mr. Babcock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

Bid was awarded to Randy Hansen Chevrolet at \$18,304.04 BIDS: for furnishing a new 1991 Chevrolet van to the college. MOTION was made by Dr. Scholes. Affirmative vote unanimous.

DR. BRADLEY: Recognition was given for Program-of-the-Year awards that were received by the college at the recent Vocational Summer Conference.
