MINUTES OF September 21, 1992, were approved as written on MOTION by Bill Babcock. Affirmative vote was unanimous.

TREASURERS REPORT: Acceptance of the Treasurer's report was approved on MOTION by Dr. Chuck Lehrman. Affirmative vote was unanimous.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: President Jerry Meyerhoeffer reported the
following:

- 1. The FY 92 audit was accepted by the Board on MOTION by Dr. Chuck Lehrman. Affirmative vote was unanimous.
- 2. The procedures for the upcoming trustee election to be held on December 22, 1992 were briefly discussed.
- 3. Dr. Joan Edwards presented a detailed description of the transactions of involving the Breckenridge annuity trusts and Breckenridge Ag Endowment. She noted that the transactions had been a success largely due to the efforts of volunteers in the foundation who have given their professional time freely.

- 4. Rosemary Barta presented the CSI Employee Handbook to the Board. She was commended by the Board for the outstanding job she did on the handbook.
- 5. Dr. Orval Bradley gave a report on the survey of students who graduated from CSI in Vocational Education in 1987-88. The results indicated a high level of satisfaction with the staff and programs at CSI.
- Dr. Bradley discussed the trends in vocational education at CSI over the last five years and future direction of vocational education programs. He noted that although ten programs had been closed, five new programs had taken their place. He also emphasized the importance of staff training and development to enable instructors to train students for new industries coming into the area.

Dr. Bradley stated that future vocational programs would involve multi-media education, telecommunications and close coordination with 2+2 programs at the high school level.

Dr. Bradley noted that CSI had a 20% increase in vocational students while receiving a 6 - 10% decrease in funding. Capital outlay funds have been cut to the point where an additional year without funds for capital outlay will have a direct negative impact upon programs.

Election of Trustees Re:

The Trustee positions currently held by LeRoy Craig and Dr. Charles Lehrman are up for election this year. There have been several changes to school district election laws since the last election.

The following items contain general information concerning the election:

- 1. As in the past, the election will be held on the first Tuesday after the third Monday in December. The election date this year is Tuesday, December 22, 1992.
- Petitions for candidates must be turned in to me by 5:00 p.m. on the fifth Friday prior to the election. Petitions are due

Friday November 20, 1992.

This early requirement is a change from previous years and is outlined in Idaho Code section 33-502. I.C. 502B provides that if the Trustee positions are not contested, an election need not be held.

There is a provision for write in candidates to file up to as late as 5 days prior to the election. This means that we will have to make all of the preparations for the election regardless of the number of petitions turned in by November 20th.

- Advertising the notice of the deadline for filing a declaration of candidacy must be for not less than two weeks in the predominant newspaper of each county and must be posted in both the Twin Falls and Jerome County courthouses for not less than 10 days.
- 4. The election must be advertised in the newspaper at least one time per week for two weeks prior to the election and posted in the Twin Falls and Jerome County courthouses for not less than 10
