MINUTES OF December 16, 1996 were approved as written on MOTION by Dr. Thad Scholes. Affirmative vote was unanimous.

TREASURERS REPORT: The Treasurer's Report for December was approved on MOTION by Bill Babcock. Affirmative vote was unanimous.

BIDS:

1. The Board approved the low bid of J Bar S Construction of Filer, Idaho in the amount of \$324,994.00 for the remodel of the old Taylor Building library on MOTION by Dr. Thad Scholes. Affirmative vote was unanimous.

Funding for this project is from the Division of Public Works.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

1. The President reported the following:

a. Headcount was up 12% and FTE increased by 5% for the current semester when compared with enrollment in the

spring of 1996.

- b. Dr. Terry Donicht sent a letter thanking the College for the free technology classes offered to public school teachers. The President stated that over 1,000 public school teachers took technology classes from the College last fall.
- c. Twelve years ago the College of Southern Idaho Foundation gave out \$16,000 in scholarships. This year the foundation will give out nearly \$500,000 in scholarships.
- d. The President gave the Board copies of the Employee Assistance Plan quarterly usage report.
- e. The <u>Tower</u> will be in color for the first time when its next issue is published later this week.
- f. The <u>Junior College Review</u> had an article about our volleyball team.
- g. <u>Northern Lights</u> published an article by English instructor Brenda Pettinger.
- 2. Penny Glenn, outgoing president of the Faculty Senate, introduced Alice Anderson as the incoming president. Ms. Glenn reviewed accomplishments of the Faculty Senate and praised Dr. Beck and President Meyerhoeffer for their assistance and support.
- 3. Jim Dawson, Athletics Academic Advisor, reported the following grade point averages for athletic teams:

Womens's Basketball	3.19

Baseball	3.01
Women's Cross Country	3.14
Men's Cross Country	2.83
Volley Ball	2.77

Dr. Lehrman thanked Jim Dawson for his work noting that the Board was pleased with the academic progress of the athletes.

4. Dr. Jerry Beck reported on television and internet courses being offered by the College. He noted that only 3% of our courses were being offered via two way interactive telecommunications while 10% of our courses were offered via some method involving distance learning. He also noted that we had 68 hours of instruction going to outreach centers and 15 hours to high schools each week.

- 5. Dr. John Martin explained the new proposed admissions policy to the Board. The Board agreed to take the policy under advisement and will discuss it again at a later date.
- 6. Jim Woods reported on the Herrett Center activities for the past year. He noted that over 34,000 visitors went through the center and that they hoped to increase this number to 45,000 next year.
- 7. President Meyerhoeffer discussed our Joint Finance Appropriations Committee presentation with the Board. He noted that we would have difficulty getting a maintenance of current operations budget this year and that next years projections were not much better. The times are similar to the early 80's.

Re: Old Taylor/Library Remodel Bid

As listed on the attached page, we received six bids for the specified remodel work. Based upon a review of the bids by Dave Shurtleff of the Division of Public Works, I recommend that the we award the bid to J Bar S Construction of Filer, Idaho in the amount of \$324,994 for the remodel work.

In addition to the remodel project, we are completely reworking the HVAC system in the Taylor Building. This is expected to cost approximately \$132,000 if we buy the parts and do most of the installation with existing staff. \$32,000 will be paid for from a Division of Water Resources Energy Conservation grant with the balance coming from budgeted Plant Facility Funds.

We also are planning on spending up to \$70,000 from budgeted Plant Facility Funds for furnishings for the remodeled space.
