#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Vice President Harmon reviewed the current General Fund budget timeline with the Board. He will bring the FY23 General Fund budget request to June meeting of the Board of Trustees seeking approval. With the Idaho State Legislature fully funding Continuing Employee Compensation (CEC), and robust enrollment, the college budget remains solid.

President Fisher reviewed with the board the process of issuing employment letters to Staff and employment contracts to Faculty.

Vice President Harmon updated the Board of the approval by the City of Twin Falls to expand the College PUD to include adjacent land that was previously considered R4.

Vice President Harmon updated the Board on the status of the CSI Trans IV operations. With the City of Twin Falls becoming Small Urban based on the 2020 decennial census, the college no longer qualifies to receive funding from Idaho Department of Transportation (ITD). Future ITD transportation funding will be awarded directly to the city.
