### **MEMORANDUM**

Re: Trustee Vacancy Replacement Framework

Date: November 21, 2022

In anticipation of a possible vacancy on the College of Southern Idaho Board of Trustees, I have prepared a framework that could be used, subject to your approval, to identify the individual to fill a vacancy on the Board. I am attaching a <u>draft</u> document that would be a beginning point

for the Trustees' discussion at a special meeting.

As noted in the accompanying document, Idaho statute and CSI Board of Trustees *Bylaws* define some of the requirements. However, the mechanism to promulgate the opportunity is not defined by statute or the *Bylaws*; hence, the accompanying document attempts to provide clarity of how the College would accomplish the replacement.
