The EMS Programs at the College of Southern Idaho provides a comprehensive education to a diverse student population in order to create competent, compassionate, and professional entry level EMTs and Paramedics who will meet and serve the emergency medical needs of the Magic Valley Region and beyond.

Emergency Medical Services Program Goals:

- Recognize and perform in the role, function, and responsibilities of an EMT, AEMT, or Paramedic in both the emergency care and operational aspects of EMS in the health care delivery system as defined by the Idaho Bureau of EMS and the National Registry of EMT's.
- Safely demonstrate competence in patient assessment and in skills as referenced to the current National EMS Education Standards for Emergency Medical Technicians, Advanced Emergency Medical Technicians and Paramedics and the State of Idaho Training Standards.
- Use effective communication skills in written and verbal situations.
- Apply legal and ethical principles in a variety of situations.
- Recognize and properly respond to the affective needs of the patient.
- Demonstrate competence in the use and care of the equipment required for optimum patient care and safety.
