REPEATED COURSES: The most recent course grade will be used. Points will be awarded as such:

- All courses may be repeated once (even if course received a "W") to be awarded full points contingent of grade earned.

- If a course is repeated three or more times (even if the course received a "W"), the grade earned will be awarded zero points.
