- ENGL 101 English (or ENGL 102)
- COMM 101 Communications (or COMM 209)
- BIOL 105 Human Structure and Function (or BIOL 227/228 Human Anatomy & Philosophy II and II)
- General education elective
- PSYC 101 Psychology or SOCY 101 Sociology
- Any General Education Math requirement
- ALLH 101 Medical Terminology
- Completion of ECT or CNA program (current certification required)
- Top 24 applicants (based on scores) will be selected for an interview

Fall start, 14 students selected.  
Full time, daytime courses, M-F.
