

## College of Southern Idaho Surgical Technology Student Work Policy

1. The clinical phase of instruction will be educational, focusing on clinical competencies for each surgical area.
2. When a student demonstrates proficiency, the student may be permitted to function alone **with appropriate supervision and direction** (preceptor available, and in the room). This practice will be monitored by the coordinator of the Surgical Technology Program when visiting or calling the clinical facility and in reviewing the student's clinical evaluations.
3. Students hired by a facility and are working for that facility when they are NOT in clinical, **will not be covered under the liability insurance purchased by the College of Southern Idaho.**
4. Students must attend clinicals physically and mentally ready to work and learn. Students suffering from physical/mental states that inhibit their ability to work safely will be barred from clinical participation until cleared for clinicals by their medical provider.
